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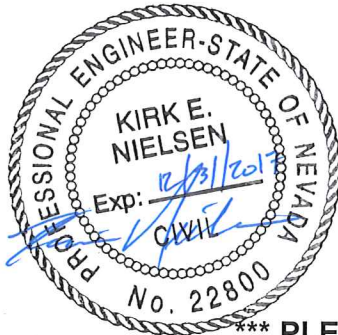

APPLICABLE LINE ON SUBMITTED BID PROPOSAL \*\*\*

To All Bidders: You are requested to make all changes and/or additions contained in this addendum to the Bidding Documents. Failure to acknowledge this Addendum in Proposal shall result in rejection of bid. Bidders are informed that the above referenced Contract Documents, Specifications and Plans are modified as follows as of July 31, 2017:

## 1. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS

**Contract Documents:** Division 4

**Section:** 60-05

**Revision:** The entire section shall be revised in its entirety to read as follows: “An Engineer’s Field Office will not be required for this project.” (See attached Division 4-31)

**Contract Documents:** Division 7

**Section:** Nevada Wage Rates

**Revision:** Amendments No. 1, 2, 3, and 5 have been added in their entirety to the 2017 Prevailing Wage Rates for Elko County provided for in Division 7 of the Contract Documents and have been attached to this addendum.

## 2. PLANS

**Plan Sheet:** E200 (24 OF 24)

**Revision:** Detail 1, revise note that reads “FIBERGLASS MAST INSTALL PLUMB” to read as “FIBERGLASS OR STEEL MAST INSTALL PLUMB”.

## 3. QUESTIONS

1. **Question:** *Would a concrete mix accepted and used under Nevada Department of Transportation projects be acceptable for use on this project?*

**Answer:** Only concrete that meets the requirements of Item P-610 Structural Portland Cement Concrete of the Contract Documents will be accepted for use of the project. A concrete mix design must be submitted for review and accepted prior to use on the project.

2. **Question:** *How and where is the source of water to be obtained for use on the project?*

**Answer:** The Contractor shall coordinate with the City of Elko to obtain a water meter and appropriate location to obtain water for use on the project.

3. **Question:** *What is the Engineer’s estimate for the project?*

**Answer:** The Engineer’s estimate for the project is within the range \$1.7 – \$2.5 Million.

4. **Question:** *What are the requirements for final acceptance of seeding?*

**Answer:** Please refer to Section 901-3.4 of the Contract Documents. The Contractor shall establish a good stand of grass of uniform color and density to the satisfaction of the Engineer. A grass stand shall be considered adequate when bare spots are one

square foot or less, randomly dispersed, and do not exceed 3% of the area seeded. Following completion of the project, the project site will be inspected to ensure this requirement has been met. Re-vegetation or other remedial actions may be required of the Contractor if these requirements are not met upon inspection at no additional cost to the Sponsor.

**No further questions will be received.**

- 4078           **b.** The Engineer shall have full entry at all reasonable times to such parts of the plant that  
4079           concern the manufacture or production of the materials being furnished.  
4080
- 4081           **c.** If required by the Engineer, the Contractor shall arrange for adequate office or working  
4082           space that may be reasonably needed for conducting plant inspections. Office or working  
4083           space should be conveniently located with respect to the plant.  
4084

4085 It is understood and agreed that the Owner shall have the right to retest any material that has been  
4086 tested and approved at the source of supply after it has been delivered to the site. The Engineer shall  
4087 have the right to reject only material which, when retested, does not meet the requirements of the  
4088 contract, plans, or specifications.  
4089

4090 **60-05 ENGINEER'S FIELD OFFICE.** An Engineer's Field Office will not be required for this  
4091 project.  
4092

4093 **60-06 STORAGE OF MATERIALS.** Materials shall be so stored as to assure the preservation of  
4094 their quality and fitness for the work. Stored materials, even though approved before storage, may  
4095 again be inspected prior to their use in the work. Stored materials shall be located to facilitate their  
4096 prompt inspection. The Contractor shall coordinate the storage of all materials with the Engineer.  
4097 Materials to be stored on airport property shall not create an obstruction to air navigation nor shall  
4098 they interfere with the free and unobstructed movement of aircraft. Unless otherwise shown on the  
4099 plans, the storage of materials and the location of the Contractor's plant and parked equipment or  
4100 vehicles shall be as directed by the Engineer. Private property shall not be used for storage purposes  
4101 without written permission of the Owner or lessee of such property. The Contractor shall make all  
4102 arrangements and bear all expenses for the storage of materials on private property. Upon request,  
4103 the Contractor shall furnish the Engineer a copy of the property Owner's permission.  
4104

4105 All storage sites on private or airport property shall be restored to their original condition by the  
4106 Contractor at his or her entire expense, except as otherwise agreed to (in writing) by the Owner or  
4107 lessee of the property.  
4108

4109 **60-07 UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS.** Any material or assembly that does not conform to  
4110 the requirements of the contract, plans, or specifications shall be considered unacceptable and shall  
4111 be rejected. The Contractor shall remove any rejected material or assembly from the site of the  
4112 work, unless otherwise instructed by the Engineer.  
4113

4114 Rejected material or assembly, the defects of which have been corrected by the Contractor, shall not  
4115 be returned to the site of the work until such time as the Engineer has approved its use in the work.  
4116

4117 **60-08 OWNER FURNISHED MATERIALS.** The Contractor shall furnish all materials  
4118 required to complete the work, except those specified, if any, to be furnished by the Owner. Owner-  
4119 furnished materials shall be made available to the Contractor at the location specified.  
4120

4121 All costs of handling, transportation from the specified location to the site of work, storage, and  
4122 installing Owner-furnished materials shall be included in the unit price bid for the contract item in  
4123 which such Owner-furnished material is used.  
4124

4125 After any Owner-furnished material has been delivered to the location specified, the Contractor shall  
4126 be responsible for any demurrage, damage, loss, or other deficiencies that may occur during the  
4127 Contractor's handling, storage, or use of such Owner-furnished material. The Owner will deduct
