



Inspection Request Change

Due to a recent increase in building inspections, the City of Elko Building Department is requesting that inspections be called in prior to **7:30 am** (for that day) instead of the usual 8:00 am cut-off. This extra half hour will allow the inspectors to be in the field earlier. Please be aware that as of Tuesday September 3rd, your inspections may be scheduled for the next day if you call after 7:30am.

The increase in inspections is also causing some roll-over from the previous day. Building staff may not be able to get to all inspections as requested. Personnel from the Building Department will do their best to notify you of a reschedule time. If you are concerned that your inspection may not have taken place, please contact our office.

To accommodate the inspection demand, a new part time inspector was recently brought on board. Please help us in welcoming Jeff Ford to the inspection team. Jeff may be a familiar face to many of you as he has been in the construction industry for many years.
