

Leaf Collection Pick-up Schedule
NO SOD, GRASS, WEEDS, OR OTHER MATERIAL, LEAVES AND TWIGS ONLY!

The City of Elko will be conducting their annual leaf collection program from Monday, October 29th, through Friday, November 30th, 2018. Please place your leaves and small twigs in garbage bags and place them on the curb for City crews to pick up. Please do not place leaves in alleys. **Leaves not placed close to the curb will not be picked up.** City crews will not enter private property to retrieve leaves. Leaves will be picked up according to the following schedule.

Crews will only pick up leaves within the Elko City Limits.

City crews will not pick up leaves that are located in trailer parks or other private property.

The City of Elko Public Works Department will provide plastic bags to citizens of the City of Elko. The bags will be available, **after October 22nd**, at the **Public Works Department**, 232 South 10th Street; **City Hall**, 1751 College Avenue; **Elko Fire Department**, 911 West Idaho Street; **Elko City Landfill**, 2200 Pinion Road; and the **Elko Police Department**, 1448 Silver Street.
